*Ordered,* That notwithstanding Rule XXII, at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader in consultation with Republican Leader, the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the nominations of Todd Gee, of the District of Columbia, to be United States Attorney for the Southern District of Mississippi for the term of four years and Tara K. McGrath, of California, to be United States Attorney for the Southern District of California for the term of four years.

*Ordered further,* That there be two minutes for debate equally divided in the usual form on the nominations.

*Ordered further,* That upon the yielding back of time the Senate proceed to vote without intervening action or debate on the nominations in the order listed, the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table with no intervening action or debate and the President be immediately notified of the Senate's actions and the Senate resume legislative session.
