### UNANIMOUS-CONSENT AGREEMENT

*Ordered, by unanimous consent,* That on the calendar day of Tuesday, July 8, 1947, at the hour of 4 p. m., the Senate proceed to vote without further debate upon any motion that may be pending or that may be made with respect to the nomination of Joe B. Dooley to be a United States district judge for the northern district of Texas, and upon the question of advising and consenting to the said nomination; that on said day the time between the meeting of the Senate and the said hour of 4 p. m., be equally divided between those favoring and those opposing the said nomination, to be controlled, respectively, by the senior Senator from Texas (Mr. Connally) and the junior Senator from Texas (Mr. O'Daniel).
