UNANIMOUS-CONSENT AGREEMENT

Ordered, That upon the completion of morning business on Wednesday, March 1, 1967, the Senate go into executive session to consider the treaties on the Executive Calendar; and at that time and without further debate of the treaties, the Senate act on them, as follows:

(1) The first three treaties on the calendar, Calendar Nos. 1 through 3, inclusive, be considered and voted on en bloc.

(2) That the fourth and fifth treaties on the calendar, Calendar Nos. 4 and 5, be considered and voted on en bloc.

(3) That the next five treaties on the calendar, Calendar Nos. 6 through 10, inclusive, be considered and voted on en bloc.
