## UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

**James Maxwell Moody, Jr. (Cal. No. 570)**

*Ordered*, That at 11:05 a.m., on Tuesday, February 25, 2014, the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the nomination of James Maxwell Moody, Jr., of Arkansas, to be United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Arkansas with the time until 11:15 a.m. equally divided and controlled in the usual form and that at 11:15 a.m. all post-cloture time with respect to the Moody nomination be dispensed with and the Senate proceed to vote on confirmation of the nomination.

*Ordered further*, That following disposition of the Moody nomination, the Senate proceed to vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the nomination of James Donato, of California, to be United States District Judge for the Northern District of California, and that if cloture is invoked, all post-cloture time be dispensed with and the Senate proceed to vote on confirmation of the Donato nomination.

*Ordered further*, That following disposition of the Donato nomination, the Senate proceed to vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the nomination of Beth Labson Freeman, of California, to be United States District Judge for the Northern District of California, that if cloture is invoked, all post-cloture time be dispensed with and the Senate proceed to vote on the confirmation of the Freeman nomination.

*Ordered further*, That all votes after the first vote be 10 minutes in length; and that with respect to the above mentioned nominations the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table with no intervening action or debate; that the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate then resume legislative session.
