Amendment

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- **Strikes GOP entitlement commission including unelected individuals and replaces with a commission composed of the bipartisan membership of the Finance, Ways and Means, Energy and Commerce Committees, and House and Senate Budget Committees – commission recommendations to be considered under regular order in the Senate and House**
- **Strikes GOP spending commission including unelected individuals and replaces with a commission composed of the Standing Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives – commission recommendations to be considered under regular order in the Senate and House**

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Entitlement Commission Description

Subtitle A. National Commission on Entitlement Solvency. Section 401. Establishment of Commission.

(a) Establishment. There is hereby established a commission to be known as the “National Commission on Entitlement Solvency,” which shall also be known as the “Senate Finance Committee and the House and Senate Budget Committees and the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives.”

(b) Purpose. The Commission shall conduct a comprehensive review of the Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid programs for purposes of analyzing their current and long-term actuarial financial condition, potential solutions to problems that threaten their long-term solvency, and providing recommendations that will ensure their long-term solvency.

(c) Duties. The Commission shall conduct a comprehensive review of the Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid programs and shall submit a report not later than May 1, 2007 on the long-term solvency of the Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid programs that contains a detailed statement of the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the Commission to the President and Congress.

(d) Membership. The Commission shall be composed of the members of the Senate Finance Committee and the members of the House and Senate Budget Committees and the members of the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives.

(e) Administration – The Rules of the Commission shall consist of the Rules of the Senate Finance Committee and the House and Senate Budget Committees and the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives, pursuant to which members of the Commission shall meet, hold hearings, require the attendance of witnesses, take testimony, and other such activities as are necessary to carry out the duties of the Commission.

(f) Funding – The Members of the Commission are already compensated for their service and no other compensation shall be necessary.
