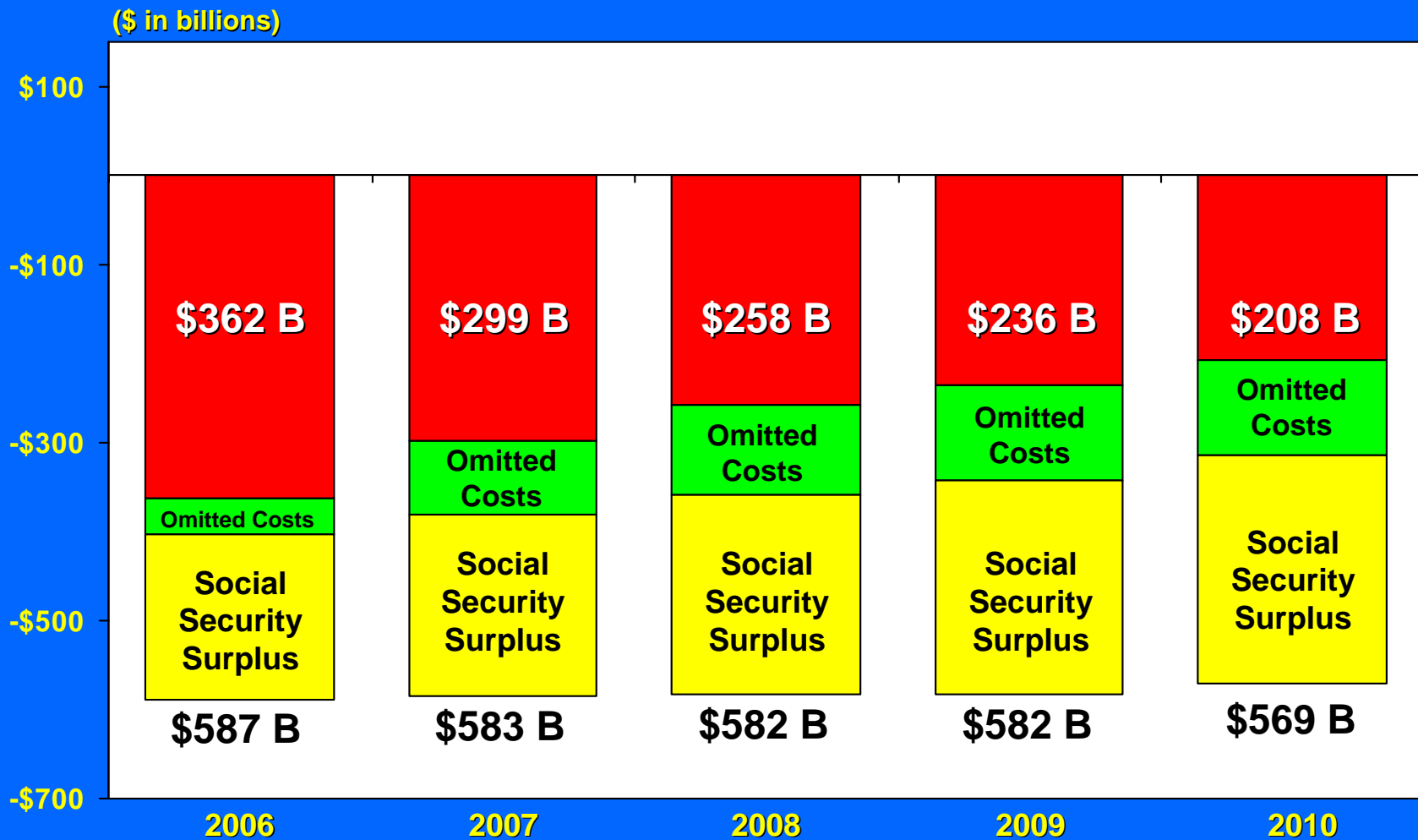

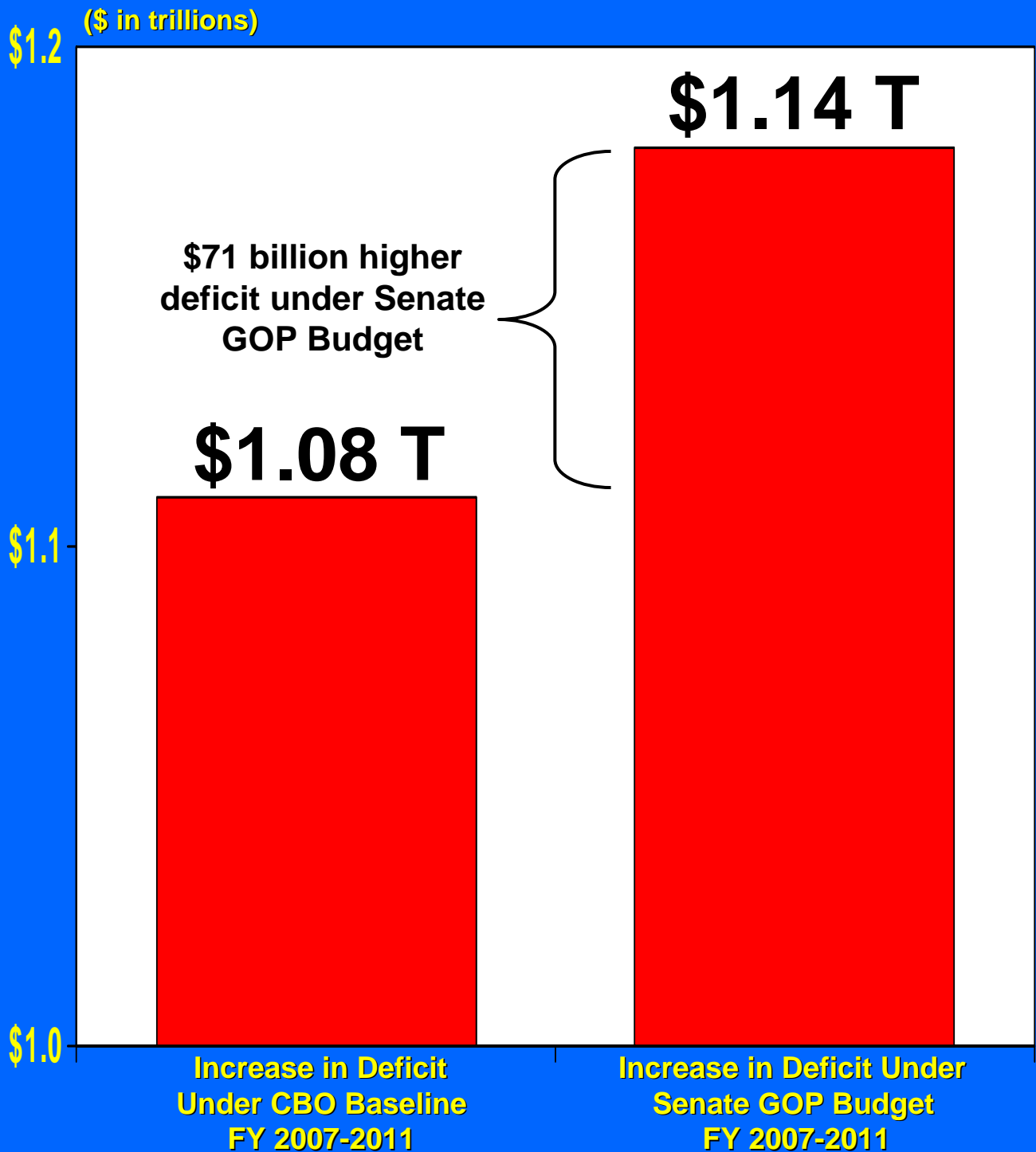

# Senate GOP Budget: \$71 Billion Worse Than Doing Nothing

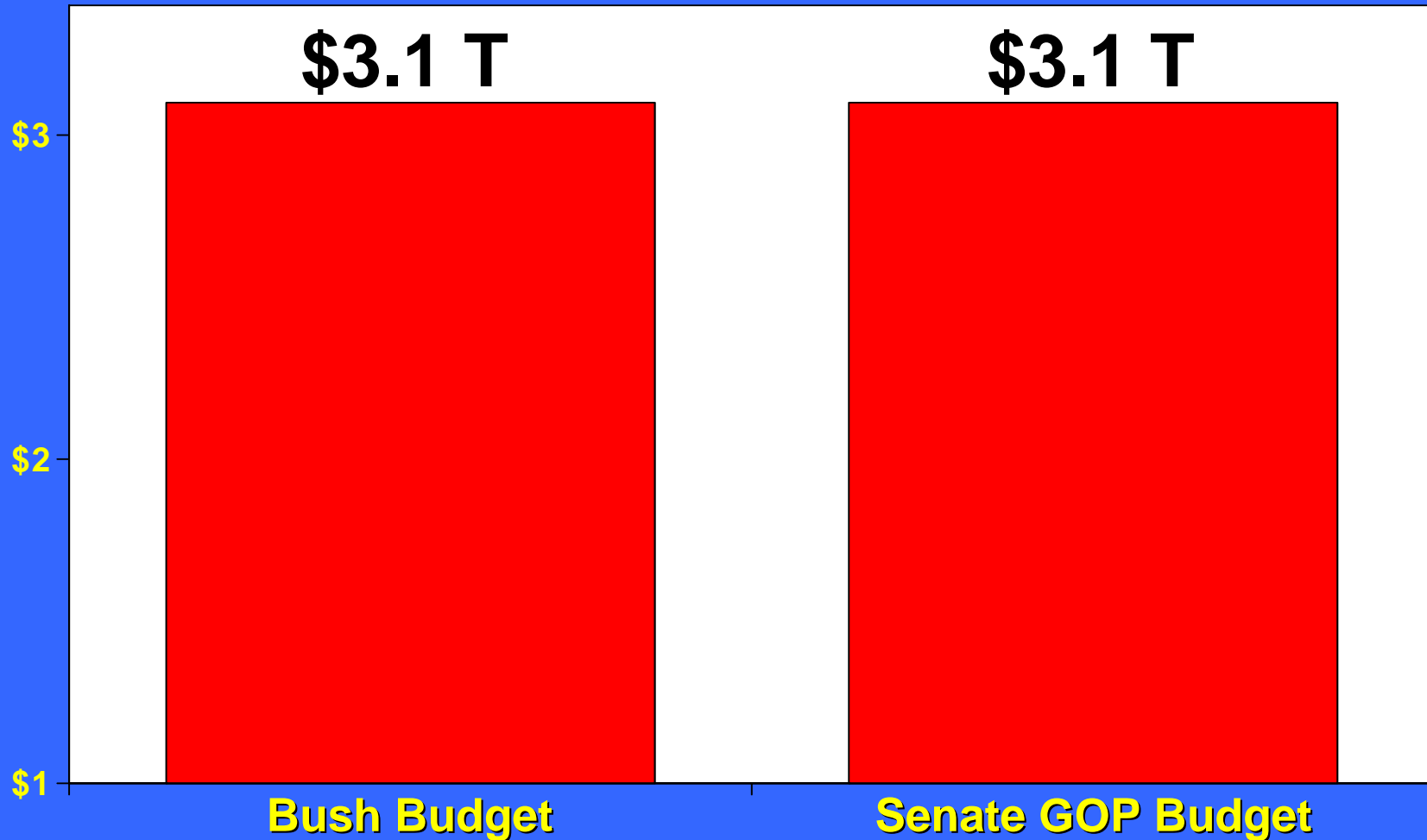

(\$ in trillions)

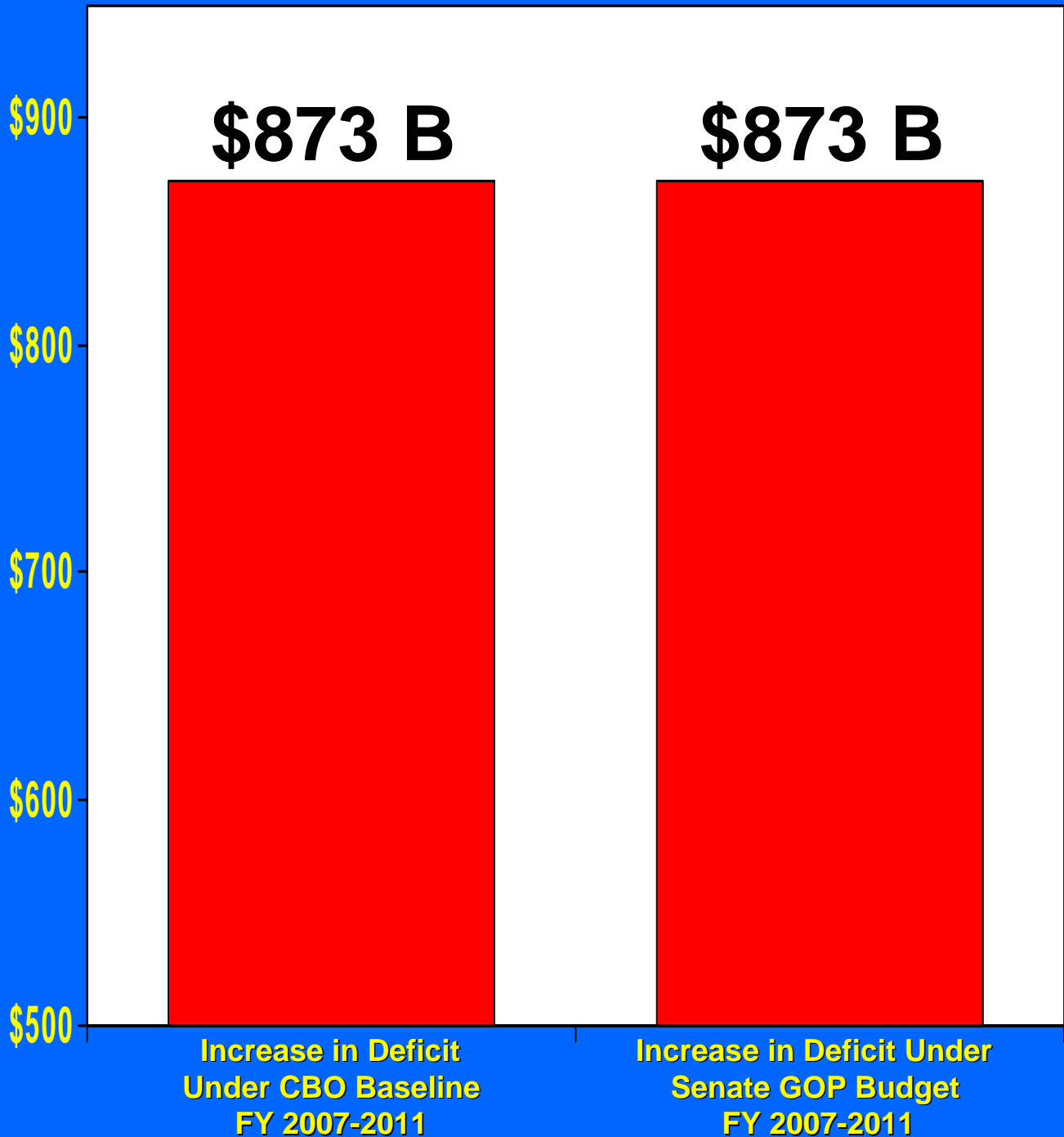
