**Senate Budget Committee Releases Current Tally
 of Hurricane-Related Spending**

The Senate Budget Committee today released a current tally of congressional legislation related to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Total hurricane-related relief enacted or passed by the Senate now totals \$75.338 billion.




Cost of Legislative Response to Domestic Emergencies (\$ in billions, constant 2005 dollars)
