New York's Manufacturing Industry Over the Last Three Years

With the New York State Department of Labor estimating that New York State has lost tens of thousands of manufacturing jobs since 2001, US Senator Charles E. Schumer today called on the federal government to take immediate action to preserve and increase manufacturing jobs and released the following study to illustrate the scope of the problem for New York's manufacturing industry over the last three years. The study compares the number of manufacturing jobs in each county in August of 2001 to the number of jobs in August 2004 and finds that tens of thousands of jobs have been lost over that period. **The following is a county-by-county estimate of the number of manufacturing jobs in upstate New York.**

Capital Region: Over the last three years, approximately 5,360 manufacturing jobs in the Capital Region have been lost.
