

By His Excellency, Thomas W. Hardwick, Governor of said State

To The Honorable Reherra Latimer Helton, Greeting:

Impereus, in conformity with the provisions of the Constitution and laws of this State, you were on the third day of October, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-two, appointed Senator in the Congress of the United States,

Now, Therefore, By virtue of the power and authority in me vested by the Constitution and laws of this State, and in pursuance of your appointment, I do hereby commission you the said Reherra Latimer Helton, Senator in the Congress of the United States from the State of Georgia.

This Commission Shall Continue in Force from third day of October, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-two, and until your successor is elected and qualified, unless the same shall be sooner vacated or annulled in the manner authorized by the Constitution and Laws of this State.
