Ye, that among the Records and Proceedings of the General Assembly of Delaware, at a Session thereof holden at Dover in the said State, on the twenty fifth Day of October, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight, it is thus contained:

The Council and House of Assembly met in the Council-Chamber, and proceeded by joint Ballot, to the Election of Senators to represent this State in the Senate of The United States; and the Ballots being taken and examined, George Read and Richard Bassett, Esquires, were declared to be duly elected.

All and singular which Premises, by the Tenor of these Presents, is exemplified. In Testimony whereof the said Vice-President hath set his Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the said State to be affixed, to these Presents, in the County of Kent, this Sixth Day of March, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Nine, and in the Year of The Independence of The United States the Thirtieth.
