Be it known that on the thirtieth day of September, in the  
Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty eight, The Honourable  
William Maclay and Robert Morris Esquires were by the Ge-  
neral Assembly of this State, being the Legislature thereof, duly elected and  
chosen at the Time and Place, and in the Manner by the said Legislature pre-  
scribed, Senators of and from the said State, to compose with the Sena-  
tors elected by the Legislatures of the States who have ratified the Constitu-  
tion for the United States, the Senate of the United States, agreeably to the  
Constitution thereof

Signed by Order of the House, this twenty eighth  
Day of February in the Year of our Lord One thousand  
seven hundred and eighty nine, and in the thirteenth Year of the  
Independance of the United States,
