In Senate, May. 18. 1789.

Resolved, that a Committee to consist of Mr. Lee
on the part of the Senate be appointed to join a Committee of the
House of Representatives to present to the President the Bill
entitled "An Act to regulate the time and manner of adminis-
tering certain Oaths," after it shall be engrossed, examined and
signed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and
the President of the Senate.
