- All requests for image use in future editions or renewals must be submitted in writing as a separate request.
- In limited circumstances, the Office of Senate Curator may request a copy of the final publication for its records.
- There are no permission fees associated with the use of U.S. Senate Collection images.
- Permission may be revoked if the terms of use are violated.

Copyright

- Materials in the U.S. Senate Collection include original and copy photographs created from countless sources, including newspaper staff, wire services, commercial photo studios, publicity photo distributors, and amateur photographers, many of which may be restricted by copyright.
