Pursuant to lawful authority, YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to make available to the SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN ACTIVITIES of the Senate of the United States on Tuesday, February 12, 1974, at 10:00 a.m. at Room 1418, Dirksen Senate Office Building the following:

(a) Any and all logs or other documents which reflect the time and duration of any and all meetings and conversations between President Richard M. Nixon and Richard Danner from January 1, 1969 to the present, including but not limited to those conversations or meetings occurring on or about July 3, 1970, in San Clemente, California and May 19, 20, and 21, 1973 at Camp David, Maryland.

(b) Any and all records and documents or copies thereof, including but not limited to notes, files, correspondence, electronic tape or dictabelt recordings, or memos which reflect the substance, subject matter or nature of any and all meetings and conversations between President Richard M. Nixon and Richard Danner from January 1, 1969 to the present, including but not limited to those conversations or meetings occurring on or about July 3,
