AN ACT

To provide increased revenue from imports, to pay interest on the public debt, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 [That, from and after the date of the passage of this act,
4 in lieu of the duties heretofore imposed by law on the
5 articles hereinafter mentioned, and on such as may now
6 be exempt from duty, there shall be levied, collected,
7 and paid, on the goods, wares, and merchandise herein
8 enumerated and provided for, imported from foreign coun-
9 tries, the following duties and rates of duty, that is to say:
10 First. On raw sugar, commonly called Muscovada or brown
11 sugar, and on sugars not advanced above number twelve,
12 Dutch standard, by claying, boiling, clarifying, or other pro
