Rept. No. 4, 79th Cong, 2d sess).

E (79th Cong, 1st sess)	A convention between the United States of America and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on the estates of deceased persons, signed at Washington on Apr. 16, 1945	Reported favorably without amendment, and with a printed report (Ex. Rept. No. 5 79th Cong, 2d sess).
