#### NOMINATIONS PLACED ON THE SECRETARY'S DESK

##### In the Diplomatic and Foreign Service

The nominations beginning Burnett F. Anderson, to be a Foreign Service officer of class 1, a consul general, and a secretary in the diplomatic service of the United States of America, and ending James L. Meyer, to be a Foreign Service officer of class 6, a vice consul of career, and a secretary in the diplomatic service of the United States of America, which nominations were received by the Senate and appeared in the Congressional Record on Apr. 13, 1965.
