### UNANIMOUS-CONSENT AGREEMENT

Ordered, That the Senate vote not later than 3:00 p. m. on Thursday, March 16, 1967, on the resolution of ratification of the treaty Executive D, 88th Congress, second session, a consular convention with the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, with the debate to be equally divided and controlled by the Senator from Arkansas (Mr. Fulbright) and the Senator from South Dakota (Mr. Mundt). (*March 15, 1967.*)
