### UNANIMOUS-CONSENT AGREEMENT

*Ordered,* That beginning at 12 noon on Thursday, June 13, 1968, debate on the resolution of ratification to the International Grains Arrangement of 1967 (Ex. A, 90th Cong., 2d sess.) be limited to 2 hours and 30 minutes, with the time to be equally divided and controlled by the Senator from Alabama (Mr. Sparkman) and the Minority Leader, or whoever they may designate, and that the vote on the resolution of ratification occur at 2:30 p.m.
