*Ordered*, That the Senate vote at 12 noon on Thursday, Mar. 19, 1970, on the resolution of ratification to the protocol to the International Convention for the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries (Ex I, 91st Cong., 1st sess); to be immediately followed by a vote on the resolution of ratification, with the 2 reservations, to the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations (Ex. J, 91st Cong., 1st sess); following which the nomination of George Harrold Carswell will be the pending business before the Senate.
