Ordered, That the Senate resume consideration of the nomination of Sam W. Brown, Jr. (Cal. No. 858) at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, May 25, 1994, with the time until 1 p.m. to be equally divided and controlled by the Senator from Rhode Island (Mr. Pell) and the Senator from Colorado (Mr. Brown) or their designees; that at 1 p.m., without intervening action, the Senate vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the nomination of Sam W. Brown, Jr., with the mandatory live quorum waived; and that if cloture is invoked, the Senate immediately without intervening action vote on confirmation of the nomination, the President be immediately notified of the action of the Senate and that the Senate return to legislative session.
