Unanimous Consent Agreement

Ordered, That at 9 a.m. on Friday, July 29, 1994, the Senate proceed to executive session and consideration of the nomination of Stephen G. Breyer, of Massachusetts, to be an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States (Cal. No. 1096); that there be six hours for debate, to be equally divided and controlled by the Chairman and Ranking Member of the Committee on the Judiciary or their designees; that following the use or yielding back of time, without any intervening action, the Senate vote on the nomination; that if confirmed, the motion to reconsider be tabled; that the President be immediately notified of the action of the Senate; and that the Senate return to legislative session.
