Unanimous Consent Agreement

Ordered, That at 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, January 22, 1997 the Senate proceed to Executive Session to consider the nomination of Madeleine Albright, of the District of Columbia, to be Secretary of State (Cal. No. 1); that there be 2 hours for debate equally divided in the usual form on the nomination, with an additional 10 minutes under the control of the Senator from Pennsylvania (Mr. Spector) and that immediately following the expiration or yielding back of time the Senate proceed to a vote on the confirmation of the nomination and following the conclusion of the vote, the President be notified of the Senate's action and the Senate return to legislative session.
