UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

Ordered, That on Tuesday, February 6, 2001, at 2:15 p.m., the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the nomination of Robert Zoellick, of Virginia, to be United States Trade Representative, with the rank of Ambassador, and if not reported, the nomination be discharged from the Committee on Finance, and the Senate proceed to its immediate consideration; that there be up to two hours equally divided between the Chairman (Mr. Grassley) and the Ranking Member (Mr. Baucus) of the Committee on Finance.

Ordered further, That at 4:15 p.m., the Senate proceed to vote on the nomination of Robert Zoellick, of Virginia, and following the vote the motion to reconsider be laid on the table, the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate return to legislative session.
