Protocol to the North Atlantic Treaty of 1949 on the Accession of Montenegro (T. Cal. No. 1)

Ordered, That following Leader remarks on Monday, March 27, 2017, the Senate proceed to executive session to resume consideration of the Protocol to the North Atlantic Treaty of 1949 on the Accession of Montenegro.

Ordered further, That notwithstanding the provisions of Rule XXII, the vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the Protocol to the North Atlantic Treaty of 1949 on the Accession of Montenegro occur at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, March 27, 2017. (*Mar. 23, 2017.*)
