Ordered further, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the Badalamenti nomination, the mandatory quorum call required under Rule XXII be waived.

Ordered further, That if cloture is invoked on the Badalamenti nomination, the post-cloture time be deemed expired and the confirmation vote occur at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2020.

Ordered further, That if either of the nominations are confirmed, the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table and the President be immediately notified of the Senate's actions. (May 14, 20, 2020.)
