#### UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

*Ordered*, That upon the conclusion of morning business on Wednesday, November 8, 2023, the Senate proceeded to executive session to resume consideration of the nomination of Ramon Ernesto Reyes, Jr., of New York, to be United States District Judge for the Eastern District of New York, post-cloture.

Ordered further, That at 11:30 a.m., all time on the Reyes nomination be considered expired. Ordered further, That with respect to the motions to invoke cloture on the following nominations, the mandatory quorum calls required under Rule XXII be waived:

Charlotte A. Burrows, of the District of Columbia, to be a Member of the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission for a term expiring July 1, 2028;

Brandy R. McMillion, of Michigan, to be United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Michigan;

Monica Ramirez Almadani, of California, to be United States District Judge for the Central District of California; and

Ana de Alba, of California, to be United States Circuit Judge for the Ninth Circuit.

Ordered further, That if cloture has been invoked on the Burrows nomination, all time be considered expired at 2:20 p.m.

Ordered further, That if cloture has been invoked on the McMillion nomination, the vote on

confirmation be at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader in consultation with the Republican Leader. Ordered further, That following the cloture vote on the McMillion nomination, notwithstanding Rule

XXII, the Senate resume legislative session and proceed to the consideration of S. J. Res. 38. Ordered further, That upon disposition of the joint resolution, the Senate resume executive session and

vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the Almadani nomination.

Ordered further, That if cloture is invoked on the Almadani nomination, the vote on confirmation be at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, November 9, 2023.

Ordered further, That if any nominations are confirmed during Wednesday's session, the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table, and the President be immediately notified of the Senate's actions. (Nov. 6, 7, 2023.)
